### Contributed Posters

The SRCOS Summer Research Conference will host a poster session Tuesday, June 7, 2011. All conference attendees, especially graduate students and junior faculty, are encouraged to participate in the contributed poster session sharing their research with the other conference participants. Posters in any area of statistical methodology and applications are welcome. Student posters will be entered in a competition for the Clint Miller best poster award and a series for R. L. Anderson poster awards. Awards will be determined by an anonymous panel of judges and announced at the Tuesday evening banquet.

### Graduate Student and Junior Faculty Travel Awards

The conference has funding to provide partial travel support to a limited number of graduate students and junior faculty members (out less than 2 years from doctoral degree) who present a poster in the program's poster session. The funds are provided by SRCOS and the American Statistical Association and are to be used to offset some of the costs incurred by attending the conference.

Applications may be submitted by advanced doctoral students or those who have just recently completed a Ph.D. (out less than 2 years from doctoral degree). Preference will be given to SRCOS member institution applicants. Funds will be awarded on a competitive basis. The deadline for applications is **April 15, 2011**. To apply, the applicant should send the following materials electronically to Dr. Colin Gallagher ([cgallag@clemonson.edu](mailto:cgallag@clemonson.edu)). Please submit all items simultaneously including:

1. A letter of recommendation from the student's researcher advisor
2. A copy of the paper or an extended abstract, and
3. A copy of the applicant's CV
